Welcome to the Wonderful World of Buckskins!

The International Buckskin Horse Association was incorporated in 1971 to meet the needs and desires of Buckskin owners throughout the world. IBHA operates on a world-wide basis with horses registered horses in Australia, Bahama Islands, Canada and the United States. IBHA membership is available to any person who is the owner of a Buckskin, Grulla or Dun—or anyone who is merely interested in this type of horse! IBHA members receive reduced rates on registration of horses.

IBHA recognizes the following colors as being eligible for registration:

BUCKSKIN: A true colored buckskin should be the color of tanned deerhide with black points. Shades may vary from yellow to dark gold. Points (mane, tail, legs) can be dark brown or black. Buckskin is clean of any smuttiness. Guard hairs which are buckskin colored grow through the body coat up over the base of the mane and tail.

DUN: Dun is an intense color with a hide that has an abundance of pigment in the hairs. The dun color is a duller shade than buckskin and may have a smutty appearance. Most dun horses have dark points of brown or black. Dun horses sport the "dun factor" points which include dorsal and shoulder stripes, leg barring, etc.

GRULLA: Grulla is also an intense color. The body color can be mouse, blue, dove or slate colored, with dark sepia to black points. Grulla (pronounced grew-yah) has no white hairs mixed in the body hairs. Grulla horses have the dorsal and shoulder stripes, and leg barring.

RED DUN: The Red Dun will vary in shades of red, in the range of peach to copper to rich red. In all shades, the accompanying points will be darker red or chestnut and be in contrast to a lighter body color. Red Dun must have a definite dorsal stripe to be eligible. The dorsal stripe will usually be dark red and predominant. Leg barring and shoulder stripes are common. Horses with faint dorsal stripes that do not appear on photos may be denied registration.

BRINDLE DUN: A different and unique body coloration with stripes appearing over the barrel of the body and most, if not all, the dun factor characteristics. Brindle Duns show up in the Netherlands and they are referred to as an ancient dun color. The peculiar body markings can appear in the form of tear drops or zebra stripes.

NOTE: Horses of different coat colors may appear to have dun factor characteristics—decisions on color eligibility will be made by the IBHA Dun Factor Committee should body color or eligibility be questionable. Any horses having Albino, Appaloosa, Paint or Pinto characteristics are not eligible for registration. Mature horses must be a minimum of 14 hands.

WHITE MARKINGS AND CONFORMATION: White markings on the face and lower leg are acceptable. Blue eyes are permissible providing the body color and conformation is acceptable. The horse should be a good representative of its breed— conformation varies from the Arabian type to the Quarter Horse type. Horses showing draft characteristics or undesirable inherent qualities would not be accepted for registration.

Just the facts...about Dun Factor!

Dun Factor is a desirable characteristic in the color breed. IBHA shows offer a special "Dun Factor" class which recognizes individuals with outstanding dun traits. The dun factor points include;

dorsal stripe ear tips and ear edging shoulder stripe or shadow leg barring face masking mane and/or tail frosting and guard hairs cobwebbing mottling neck shadow

Dun factor classes are open to all IBHA registered mares, stallions and geldings. It is not divided for color. sex or age. Conformation is considered in judging, not less than 10% nor more than 20%. Excessive white markings are not desirable if they cover areas where dun factor points would be.





The dorsal stripe will run along the backbone from the withors to the base of the tail. ` The width will vary, with barbs and/or brindle strips running from the stripe ideal.



White hairs which are interspersed through the mane and tail. These frosted hairs may shed during the summer months.



Ear tips and edges appear darker than the body color. Ears are usually outlined on the edges.



Leg barring can be seen on inside and outside surfaces of both front and hind less.



Neck shadowing appears as dark areas through the neck, extending into the hollow of the shoulder. Shadowing may appear only on the crest, or as dark lines pointing down from the base of the mane.



Mottling is found on the forearm, gaskins, shoulders and stifles in a circular motif.



Cobwebbing starts under the forelock and appears as lines entending in varying lengths over the forehead, or around the cyes.



Face masking can be seen as black, brown or red shading across the bridge of the nose.

It is essential that you keep accurate records. In any case where an application may be regarded as questionable, the burden of responsibility shall rest on the applicant who shall sustain any claims by a preponderance of evidence.

SECTION 1. Be sure to give three name choices when filling in application. Duplicate names may not be used and if only one name is given and that name is already in use, there will be a delay in processing of your certificate. Should a horse be registered in another registry the registered name must be first choice on this application.

SECTION 2. Fill in all known pedigree information you have regarding your horse. If unknown, state so in blank. When pedigree is claimed, we must have some sort of proof. Please furnish a breeder's certificate or copy of same, or registration certificate (or copy) from some reputable registry, or other reasonable proof. If registration certificates are sent they will be returned immediately. If you are unable to furnish proof, pedigree will be listed as "unknown".

NOTE: If animal being registered is also registered in some other breed organization, please give the registration number and name of registry.

SECTION 3. Write your natural signature, then print or type your name carefully in space provided. Give your complete mailing address and Zip Code.

BREEDERS CERTIFICATES MAY BE OBTAINED FROM THIS OFFICE ON REQUEST.

MARKINGS: On the reverse side there are diagrams showing the horse from each side. These diagrams are important. Draw all white markings in carefully (do this with the horse in front of you to be accurate). Be sure to indicate how the markings (white) appear on the legs from both front and hind views. These markings will be transferred to the registration certificate and must be an accurate description of your horse. Failure to use care could cause problems at some time if the registration certificate does not match your horse. Scars and brands must be shown on the application.

PHOTOS: Four clear color photos are required to complete the registration. Photos will be kept in the files. Photos should show the horse from right and left sides, as well as front and hind views. Stand the horse on pavement or smooth ground so that white markings on the legs are shown clearly. Foretop should be pulled aside to show face markings completely.
